David Ellenson - I. H. and Anna Grancell Professor of Jewish Religious Thought at the Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion, Los Angeles, California. His most recent book is *Between Tradition and Culture*: The Dialectics of Modern Jewish Religion and Identity (1994).

Solomon B. Freehof - (1893-1990) Rabbi of the Rodef Shalom Congregation, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; President of the Central Conference of American Rabbis, and the World Union for Progressive Judaism; Chair of the Responsa Committee of the Central Conference of American Rabbis. Author of eight volumes of responsa including *Today's Reform Responsa* (1990), as well as Reform Jewish Practice (1947, 1952), The Responsa Literature (1955), A Treasury of Responsa (1963) and many other books.

Alexander Guttmann - (1904-1993) Professor of Talmud and Rabbinics, Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion, Cincinnati, Ohio. Author of Rabbinic Judaism in the Making (1970), Studies in Rabbinic Judaism (1976), The Struggle over Reform in Rabbinic Literature, (1977) and many essays.

Walter Jacob - Rabbi of Rodef Shalom Congregation, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; President of the Central Conference of American Rabbis, Chair of the Responsa Committee; President of the Freehof Institute of Progressive Halakhah. Author and editor of twenty books including American Reform Responsa (1983), Contemporary American Reform Responsa (1987), Liberal Judaism and Halakhah (1988), Questions and Reform Jewish-Answers - New Reform Responsa (1991), The Healing Past: Pharmaceuticals in the Biblical and Rabbinic World (1993).

Jacob Z. Lauterbach - (1873-1942) Professor of Talmud and Rabbinics, Hebrew Union College, Cincinnati, Ohio. Chair of the Responsa Committee of the Central Conference of American Rabbis. Editor of Mekhilta deRav Ishmael (1933-49). Contributor to the Jewish Encyclopedia.

Daniel Schiff - Rabbi, Temple B'nai Israel, McKeesport, Pennsylvania. Lecturer for the Jewish Education Institute of Pittsburgh. Member of the Responsa Committee of the Central Conference of American Rabbis.

Mark Washofsky - Associate Professor of Rabbinics - Hebrew Union College - Jewish Institute of Religion in Cincinnati Ohio. His publications include studies on the development of *halakhic* thought in medieval and modern times. Currently Vice Chair of the Responsa Committee of the Central Conference of American Rabbis.

Moshe Zemer -Director of the Freehof Institute of Progressive Halakhah; a founder of the Movement for Progressive Judaism in Israel; Av Bet Din of the Israel Council of Progressive Rabbis. Founding Rabbi of Kedem Synagogue-Beit Daniel in Tel Aviv. Author of The Sane Halakhah (1993).
