The following table shows the results of the experiments conducted during the summer of 1904. The first column gives the name of the plant, the second the date of the experiment, the third the amount of water used, and the fourth the amount of water retained. The results show that the amount of water retained is generally less than the amount used, and that the amount retained is generally less than the amount used.
